Gospel Reflection



Today's Gospel forms part of Matthew's great Sermons or collection of Jesus' sayings. Later rewording of Jesus' words. He would not have used the word "Church." All of Ch18 deals with life inside the Christian community; in particular. How to treat problem of sin and evil. Consoling to realise not even among Jesus' early disciples was there a perfect Church! Always a group of sinners, needing guidance, correction AND forgiveness.

Jesus teaches a procedure for dealing with sin and evil...almost a legal procedure..."Brother" means a fellow believer.

Jesus asking us to go to great lengths to reclaim lost friendship; to heal hurts etc.

In teaching us the Our Father, Jesus insists that we forgive otherwise our Heavenly Father will not forgive us! Note that little word "AS" in the prayer: "As we forgive those who trespass against us" Next Sunday's Gospel will give us a long instruction on forgiveness.

We all accept warnings on labels that certain products are poisoned dangerous; can cause cancer etc. We regard these labels as good for us. We know where we stand. We appreciate how dangerous certain things really are.

Such knowledge does not depress us. On contrary it serves to emphasise values of life, health and well-being in ourselves and others.

So, with Jesus' remarks today. We have clear warning labels that some sins are truly MORTAL: they cause cancer of the soul; and if left untreated, they KILL. They need not—such is the value of warning labels. If we heed the warnings, we can avoid the disasters.
