Gospel Reflection

Today's Liturgy puts the life-giving words of Jesus before us. He is the Way, the Truth and the Life, the One in whom we can place all our trust.

Because we believe this, we gather now to offer God our praise and worship.

Lord Jesus, you have shown us your Father's love . Lord have mercy
 You have redeemed us and brought us true freedom. Christ, have mercy.

You share with us your own divine life. Lord, have mercy.
 May Almighty God have mercy on us.

In this Gospel passage we are listening in, as it were, to a very intimate conversation Jesus had with His disciples at Last Supper...after the washing of the feet. Jesus is consoling His disciples ahead of the dark times ahead of them. **He tells them: "Do not be distressed! Do not despair. Very soon, the disciples' whole world will be shattered...the scandal of the Passion and Death of Jesus will rock them to their foundations...they will run away in fear...only their blind trust in God will be left.**

There will be times, too, when we will have to believe what we cannot prove and accept what we cannot understand! Many of us know this from our experience of life and the crosses and trials that come our way: illness, death, etc.
