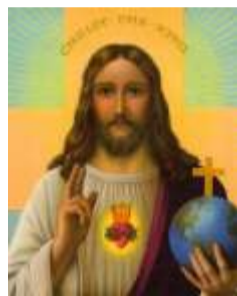

## Gospel Reflection

Feast of Christ the King  
The Living Word



Today we celebrate the kingship of Christ, remembering that this kingdom is not governed by the standards of this world. **Christ rules and judges us by God's standards of compassion and justice, and He knows and cares for all his subjects.**

**Today's Gospel reading encourages us to think seriously about how God might judge our actions as individuals when we come before our Maker. Yet there are many things in today's readings which should prompt us to look long and hard about how our society and our church community functions. The high standards of Christ, who is our king and shepherd, our judge and our advocate are placed before us. How does our society and our church community fall short of those standards? Are we targeting some areas in the search for encouragement, for results, and neglecting others which are taxing and more urgent?**

Unlike God, our powers are limited and our energies and resources are finite. Yet the Gospel calls us to aim high, to love one another as God has loved us. And God has loved us all—whether others regard us as lovable or deserving—and has sent his Son to bring the hope of eternal life to all who believe in him. **The target for God's love is the whole human race, and whether or not we can reach it, that is the target we too must aim for.**
