Gospel Reflection

A common human experience is that of being let down...of being disappointed, especially by friends, by family even...a feeling of failure sometimes. Friends I visited recently, parents of three teenagers, were agonising over the fact that their two boys and their girl were resenting **their advice and control; were also rebelling against 'religion' and going to Mass** and in general seemed to be rejecting values that the parents considered important and genuine. They were asking themselves: where did we go wrong?

In today's Gospel Matthew tells us that Jesus is facing that very problem. Jesus has selected his special disciples and started to preach the **vision of God's Kingdom (Sermon on the Mount)...has just been to Corozain and Bethsaida..."university cities"...centres of religious studies...**result? Rejection, opposition, violent too, thrown out! Despite the goodness of Jesus, his miracles, his fulfilling of the prophecies of the Old Testament (which his enemies should have been first to recognise), he was rejected, persecuted, ridiculed.

Similar experience to that met at times by parents, teachers, by a priest or religious sister and also by social workers, people in caring professions.

Jesus could have asked himself the same question and he was God! Remember, he chose 12 special disciples, trained them and yet ONE was a failure, Judas.

We can certainly take COURAGE and HOPE and renewed DETERMINATION from Jesus' example: **This is the GOOD NEWS of today's Gospel** for us.
