Gospel Reflection



We, are a Believing community, listen to the Readings we tune into our historical background...eg in today's 1st Reading, Peter witnesses to Jesus' death and Resurrection. In 2nd Reading, John praises God's forgiving power and tells us that keeping the Commandments is our way of loving God...Then the Gospel reading we should make it our business to LISTEN prayerfully to Readings.

Then we come to BREAKING of BREAD: What Jesus asked u to remember Him by...His last request before He died for us...In our Gospel story Jesus invites his disciples to TOUCH and SEE! He eats with them to prove it is really He, not a ghost or their imagination. MEALS are very important occasions for Luke...in reading Luke's Gospel we are never very far from a meal scene...Remember the Jews being shocked by Jesus 'eating and drinking with sinners'. Last Supper, of course...Jesus said: "Do this in memory of ME! One of Luke's important lessons for his readers is that their Sunday Eucharist /Mass (breaking the bread) keeps and strengthens them in their relationship with Jesus: their weekly spiritual food for life's journey.

Jesus wants each of us to Witness to Him: to be His hands and feet in our world...to witness to His values...to be Good News for others, especially those who come our way and to whom we can, if we wish, help in various ways...at a minimum by being friendly and supportive wherever we can.

It is a very awesome fact that at times any one of us may be the only Good News that some people will ever read! In what we say or do, they will experience the touch of Jesus in their lives...through our Baptism, our Confirmation and the Eucharist we share, the POWER of Jesus is with each of us to teach, heal, reconcile people and to bring peace.
