Project Compassion Sunday

Weekend 2/3 March

The readings today prepare us for the coming Lenten season, a time for prayer, fasting and almsgiving. It is also a time for stepping away from the instinct to judge one another, be that close to home, or beyond into the human family of nations.

The responsorial psalm speak of how the proclamation of justice is nourishing the work of justice is life giving. Caring for others keeps us connected to the **spirit of God, reminding us that the just will 'flourish like the palm tree and grow like a cedar of Lebanon'**.

The second reading urges us to **'never give in' and keep faithful to the Lord's work** which is to ensure that there is justice among the nations and that **peace will flourish**. The gospel reading tells us that **'the fully trained disciple will always be like the teacher'**, reminding us that **our example of living is to come from Jesus and his mission of bringing good news to the poor**. It is by what we say and do, that people will see the face of God in the world. This is the **'good' fruit**.

In the coming weeks, we have the privilege of walking with some of our sisters and brothers who participate in Caritas programmes, and who feature in the Project Compassion stories this year. How might we learn about living hope-filled lives in solidarity with one another and for the common good of our one human family? As the season of Lent approaches, we might consider: What could we do to commit ourselves to the flourishing of hope in our time? How can we give Lent 100%?

On the 9th March 2019, the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate will celebrate an historic occasion in the life of the Australian Province. This occasion will see the blessing and opening of St Mary's Seminary in Camberwell by Bishop Mark Edwards OMI. The original St Mary's Seminary was opened in Mulgrave in 1963 and saw the formation of many Oblates. In



2015 the Mulgrave property was sold and St Mary's relocated to 647 Burke Rd, adjacent to the Provincial House and Residence. After some very thorough re-development, we are excited to announce the re-location and important continuation

of St Mary's Seminary and the formation of our scholastics.

Palm Sunday

Palm Sunday 2019 will be unlike any other experienced in Fremantle, as delegates from *Choralfest 2019*, incorporate into the two morning services at St John's Anglican Church and St Patrick's Basilica. We will gather outside St John's in Kings Square around 9:15am for a blessing of the palms, then their 9:30am, return to King's Square for the Commemoration of the Lord's Entrance into Jerusalem led by Fr John Sebastian and a procession up Adelaide St to St Patrick's for the 11am Mass.

The music at St Patrick's will be led by the combined choirs of St John's, St Patrick's and The Winthrop Singers, and include the world premiere of Nicholas Bannan's Setting of The Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke.

We hope you will join us for all or part of what will be a very special morning of worship on Sunday 14 April, bringing together the Anglican and Catholic Communities of Fremantle, alongside worshipers from all around Australia.
