Gospel Reflection

It's very consoling to see that Jesus showed Himself to His disciples in such an ORDINARY way...like preparing a meal! For us, who have no miraculous powers, this is God's way of showing us how much we can do for others...just by being there for them...helping, supporting, advising, etc also praying for them...pushing our selfishness into the background as we give our time and gifts to help others.

Giving NOT moaning! Notice how Givers never moan and moaners ever give!! Special lesson also for Young People here: who can make life so enjoyable for those around them...and who have a career ahead of them...a special vocation that each of us has...Jesus asks you also to consider following Him in a special way...perhaps as a priest, religious sister, lay volunteer etc and in becoming part of your parish community's works as some of you do here e.g. Altar Servers, Youth Group etc.

Final Reflection: Jesus on shore...preparing breakfast...Model and inspiration for all the "behind-the-scenes" people who do so much in the background and out of the limelight etc, and are often overlooked e.g. The meal-makers, cleaners, decorators...all those who do voluntary work, voluntary ministry etc...all the "Martha's"...Jesus, the God of the apron, sees and blesses all your work.

And should you ever feel like despairing...remember those disciples out fishing all night and catching nothing...then Jesus comes - and what a difference He makes! Sometimes we must be busy as if it all depended on us and PRAYING if it all depended on God!
