## Gospel Reflection

**Our own mission depends on how we answer Christ's question. Who do we say he is? Put another way, what is our image of Christ? What is our image of God?**

My image of God can be of a distant, punishing God who is always waiting to catch me out and rebuke me. Or he can be an abstract concept, the unmoved mover. He can also be a close friend, loving and uplifting, particularly when I am low. But does my God challenge me, asking me to live out the same pattern that we see in Jesus? And when he makes this challenge does he leave me on my own or is he my companion on the journey, not asking me to do anything except what he himself has already undertaken?

These are not always easy questions for us to answer, but we have to answer as honestly as possible because in doing so we are not just making a statement about God's identity; we are also making one about our own. We are allowing God to ask us the question: who are you? Are we really Christ's disciples and how do we understand our mission?

Just as Jesus explores the question about his identity through his life and death, so do we. It is answered in how we live out each moment until that instant of death when we join ourselves to Christ completely.
