Gospel Reflection *Pentecost Sunday*

We know from the history of the Church that it was the Presence of the Holy Spirit that gave courage to the early martyrs and the same Holy Spirit is still doing that in many places in the world where Christians are persecuted.

St John tells us that we will meet opposition from what he calls the world ie people who live as if there were no God; who leave God completely out of all their daily living.

Jesus through John, reminds us that we can only see what we are fitted to see; to see and understand when we make the effort to see and understand e.g astronomer will see more in sky than you or I; a botanist in a hedge grow; a doctor examining a person; a musician will get more out of a symphony than one know nothing about musical composition. If we have eliminated God our of our lives, then we never have time for God, we can never hear His voice of His call, we can be too busy to let the Holy Spirit have any chance to enter our lives.

The Holy Spirit is not a gate crasher! Picture of Jesus knocking at the door, handle only on the inside! We must let and invite God into our lives.

The Holy Spirit works in us to continue Jesus' work. The Holy Spirit speaks to us through others and we too can be channels of God's word and God's blessing for others. The Spirit who lives in us enables us to share in God's work by acting as advocates and comforters to those in need, as Jesus did. We do the Holy Spirit's work when we defend the defenceless by working for justice and searching for the Truth. We are inspired by the Holy Spirit when we help others by our counsel and support to live out the teachings of Jesus. And we bring God's comfort to others when we share our lives and our talents with them, thereby encourage them to live by Faith, This is a noble part of our God-given mission in life.
